UNANIMOUSLY VOTED: to request the Secretary of State to place a municipal bond authorization referendum question on a ballot for the following:

"Shall An Act authorizing the Town of South Kingstown to issue not to exceed \$150 million general obligation bonds and notes to finance the acquisition, construction, improvement, renovation, furnishing and equipping of a new high school, athletic facility, and other school facilities in the town and all expenses incident thereto, including, but not limited to, costs of design, demolition, athletic fields, landscaping and parking and all attendant expenses, including engineering, architectural and other project-related consulting costs be approved?"

Said question to be placed before the voters at an election to be held on May 7, 2024. This question is in accordance with enabling legislation pending before the RI General Assembly.
